### **Session Description**

This session will introduce the concept of linked data and why it is significant, explain the Bibframe data model and the current state of Bibframe, and explain how linked data and Bibframe are related. We will look at Library of Congress' Bibframe proof of concept sinopia.io, speculate on how a Bibframe/linked data environment might change our current work, and introduce some activities that allow users to contribute to linked data initiatives now.

Learning Outcomes

Participants will be able to recognize the concepts of linked data, resource description framework, and the Bibframe abstraction levels and core classes. Participants will have the information necessary to consider how they might contribute to linked data initiatives.


### Abstraction

Abstraction Layer or Layer of Abstraction

Intended to hide high level concepts lacking in details

Rain is the abstracted concept

The water cycle is the hidden complexity of details that produce rain

### What Is Linked Data?

Structured data linked with other structured data

• Structured data are defined by ontologies

An **ontology** defines the structure of classes, attributes, and relationships for a **domain** or subject area of interest

Data are sourced from databases of **controlled vocabularies** or **literals** 

• Literal: information that is not part of a controlled vocabulary such as extents of the resource, dates

# Why is Linked Data Significant?

Basis for the Semantic Web

- Semantic Web: structured machine readable data on the web
- Semantic Web Primer <u>http://www.linkeddatatools.com/semantic-web-basics</u>

Web 2.0 (Current iteration) relies on HTML

• HTML links web documents

Web 3.0 (Semantic Web) relies on ontologies

Ontologies give specific meaning to **Things** 

• Thing: An entity or concept that exists and is acknowledged by an ontology

Resource Description Framework (RDF) is the underlying ontology of the Semantic Web





# What is **BIBFRAME**?

Data model for bibliographic information


Work began in 2011

Bibframe 2.0 released in 2016


Organizes information into three core levels of abstraction: **Work**, **Instance**, and **Item**.

Agents, Subjects, & Events have relationships to Classes

Expected to employ RDF

RDA supports Semantic Web vocabulary

Entities Attributes Relationships (Properties)

RDF supports IFLA-LRM (FRBR) Entities, Attributes, & Relationships

MARC cannot support these concepts

BIBFRAME employs RDF, which supports the Semantic Web


